**National Toggenburg Club All-American
Nomination Form**

DEADLINE: Postmarked or received by December 31 of nomination year

Guidelines for nominating an animal:

1. To qualify for nomination each animal must meet each of these requirements:
 - a. Registered purebred or American Toggenburg.
 - b. Animal must have competed in at least one official ADGA, AGS or CGS show during the nomination year and have been awarded at least on of the following:
 - I. First in an individual class in which there was competition.
 - II. Grand or Reserve Grand Champion (Junior Doe, Senior Doe)
 - III. Senior, Res. Senior, Junior or Res. Junior Champion (Combined Doe)
 - IV. 2nd in a class with more than 10 animals competing
 - V. First in a Champion Challenge class in which there were at least two animals competing.
 - VI. Best In Show
2. Person nominating the animal must be the current owner of record of the animal being nominated. Competition is open to members and non-members of the NTC but non-members must pay a higher nomination fee.
3. If animal competed in two different age classes during the nomination year it can be nominated in both classes but a separate form and nomination fee and appropriate pictures must be completed for each class.
4. Photographs – do NOT put the animal's name or any identifying information on the photo(s). **PICTURES MUST HAVE BEEN TAKEN DURING THE NOMINATION YEAR.** Be sure they are securely attached to the nomination form with tape – do not glue them to the form. Only clear, in-focus pictures with good contrast should be used. Remember that animals will be selected based upon the picture(s) submitted. Black and white or color is acceptable. A side view picture is **REQUIRED.** An optional rear view can also be added to the form if desired. Photos should not exceed 4"x6" or be smaller than 3"x5". No retouched or Photoshopped pictures are allowed. Pictures submitted will become the property of the NTC and submitting a nomination indicates approval to use them in advertising and results releases.
5. Show wins are the basis of this award. No additional information (linear appraisal scores or production records) should be included on the form. Linear scores can be used on the animal's name since all judging is done without identification of the animal.
6. It is the owner's responsibility to verify the accuracy of all information provided on the entry form. Any entries found to be fraudulent will disqualify the animal from competition in the program.
7. All entries must be postmarked by December 31 of the nomination year. Absolutely no late entries will be accepted. Those sent electronically should have pictures attached as individual JPEG attachments. Every attempt will be made to have results completed for the March (Toggenburg) issue of United Caprine News, an issue of Dairy Goat Journal, the NTC newsletter and website.

If emailing forms they will not be considered complete until payment in full has been received no later than the December 31 deadline. Fees: NTC members \$3.50 per nomination. Non-NTC members \$7.00 per nomination.
